Western Museum of Mining & Industry United Gold Mines Collection (1902-1995)

This collection was created by merging and organizing several donations to the museum from 1992-2018. The result is a collection of material that contains the surviving records of United Gold Mines, which was founded in Victor, CO, by the Woods Brothers in 1902. UGM was one of the major companies in the Cripple Creek Mining District and competed with Golden Cycle Corporation, a Carlton family conglomerate. Golden Cycle foreclosed on all UGM properties in the Cripple Creek Mining District in 1965 and absorbed all of the UGM holdings.

Donors of this collection include Cripple Creek & Victor Gold Mining Company (1992.24, 1992.30, 1996.12, 1997.12, 1997.27, 2022.16), Frank Gorman (1999.3, 1999.20), Peter Spahn (1999.40), Robert Murray (2003.7), Malcolm E. MacDougall (2013.6), the Numismatic Museum (2017.6), Mrs. Geraldine Y. Pegler (2018.20), and CC&V Gold Mining Company (2022.16). Edward T. Hunter, an employee of the Cripple Creek & Victor Gold Mining Company, was the principal donor from that company. The late Mr. Hunter was a long-time member and frequent donor to the museum.

Condition

The financial ledgers are in good condition, with the handwritten entries still legible. The board minute books are typed and in good condition, with some yellowing, and some pages loose. The Annual Reports of the company are yellowing, some brittle, but most in good condition. Very little, if any, water and mildew damage are present, primarily in Series C, Box 16, containing pocket notebooks from the 1920s and 1930s.
